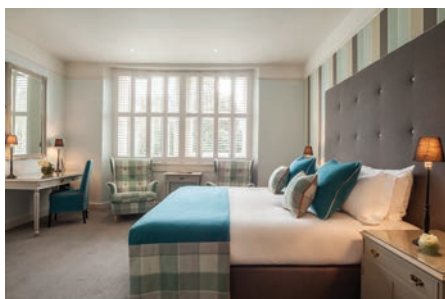
BATH



The Roseate Villa Bath occupies a quiet corner of the city, moments' walk from the heart of the iconic Bath, a city favoured for its heritage and cultural tourism. The Villa oversees the Henrietta Park, a 7 acre park opened to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Victoria in 1897. The park land was donated by Captain Forrester of 3rd Kings Own Hussars, with the stipulation that it should always remain a green space and never be built on. Henrietta Park is situated within walking distance of the city centre and key attractions like Roman Baths, Bath Abbey, Thermae Bath Spa, The Jane Austen Centre. It is an oasis of tranquility with places to sit quietly or take a relaxing stroll around the circular walk amongst many fine trees and flora that include the Purple Sycamore, Golden Elms, Caucasion Mapel and a line of Baumannii Horse Chestnuts.

The Roseate Villa Bath encompasses 2 converted Victorian houses which have had a characterful legacy. The Villa offers undivided attention to its guests with everything that the city has to offer whether it is the tour of the Roman Baths and Regency Crescent or the views of Prior Park, Jane Austen Museum and the grandeur of Bath Abbey. A boutique hotel positioned just 5 minutes away from the heart of the city, The Roseate Villa Bath exudes a feeling of serenity in and around its estate and offers wholehearted assistance to its guests who are either seeking informative excursions around the city or are in the mood for a nonchalant weekend getaway.
